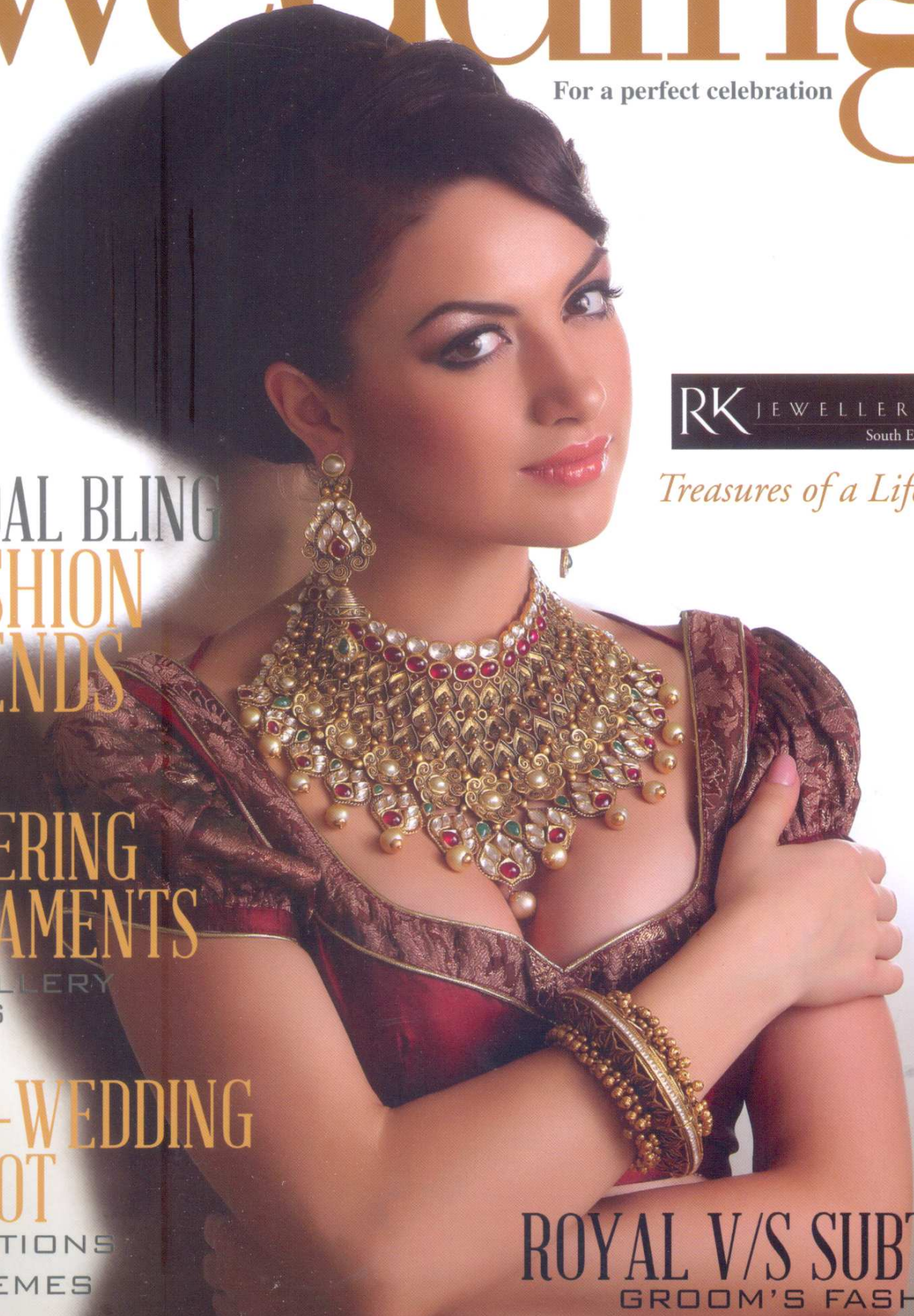

The Bucket of Buns

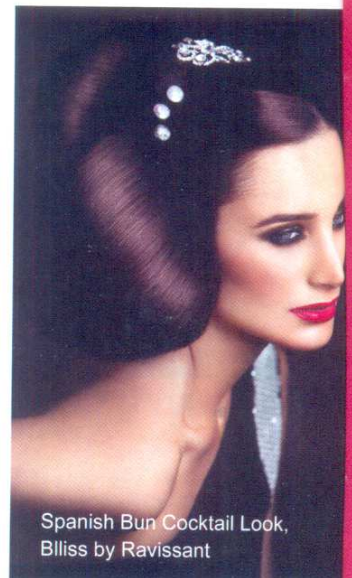
Soft Waves and Curls

Bridal Hairdos

For the bride-to-be, we got talking to experts to share a few hairdos which you can pick for different ceremonies depending on the flavour of the functions and your look. Steven Mick, international creative director, Blliss by Ravissant gives a lowdown on the Spanish bun for the cocktail ceremony:

- First of all, hair needs to be straightened and bounced.
- Do the parting in the upper head section in V from the front to the back and backcombed tightly.
- Back comb the back section also part in U section and smoothen out on the sight pinup in slight ways to a Spanish look.
- Contouring the face with middle part section with bounced wave on the sight pin up can act as a classical style as well as a modern one.
