make sure you have an arsenal of hair tools on hand to secure your style because some of them are seriously immaculate – rollers, hair-spray and plenty of pins!

Puja Taluja, a Bollywood beauty and makeup expert says, "Finger waves are a big favourite at the minute. The way to getting them right is to use a wand or a small barrel tong and a soft bristle brush. For shorter hair, try a retro pin curl. You just need lots of



lady Jane clips and a great hairspray, while quiffs will work on all hair lengths, long or short."

"Although maintaining retro hairstyle is a task, side ponytails, high ponytails, teased double buns and scarf tied up are the most commonly made. One can try the high ponytail with a hair elastic and a couple of bobby pins. It's a very neutral and versatile style. One can carry this for work or a night out and it works beautifully on unwashed hair," adds Puja.
